



## MALLALA CAMPING RULES

Mallala Motor Sport Park Pty Ltd (**Venue**) offers Camp Ground facilities at various (**Events**) to any person (**Patron**), subject to the following conditions which shall be read in conjunction with all other Attendance Conditions of the Venue.

By entering the Camp Ground, Patrons are deemed to have accepted and understood as binding on them, all Conditions of Entry to the Camp Ground and any associated risks, obligations and responsibilities.

The offer of Camp Ground facilities is entirely at the discretion of both the Venue and Promoter (**Hirer**) where applicable.

Patrons not satisfied with the Conditions of Entry cannot enter the Camp Ground at any time.

### ENTRY

Access to the Camp Ground will be subject to each Event.

1. a) A camping fee may be charged;
2. b) A non-transferable wrist band will be issued and must be worn at all times;

Note: A Camp Ground wrist band does not grant access to the Circuit and a valid ticket must be provided for circuit entry.

### ALLOWED ITEMS

Patrons may bring the following items into the Camp Ground.

Tents, marquees and other temporary structures used solely for camping purposes; i.e. Barbeques; generators and gas bottles, folding tables and chairs.

#### 1. Generators

Generators must not be operational between the hours of 10.00pm and 7.00am.

An adult must be in attendance at all times whilst the generator is operating.

Each generator must be accompanied by a fire extinguisher.

Maximum fuel allowed to be brought into the Camp Ground is 20 litres per generator and is to be safely stored in a sealed container outside the tent.

#### 2. Gas Bottles

Can be used for cooking but must be stamped in accordance with relevant laws.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

1. CAMPFIRES may NOT be lit at any time within the Mallala Motorsport Park grounds.
2. NO BBQ'S or braziers to be used inside a Pit Garage at any time.
3. NO ANIMALS are allowed at Mallala Motorsport Park other than an assistance dog required by a person with a disability.

## CONDUCT

Patrons must conduct themselves in a way deemed appropriate by the Venue and/or Promoter. Any Patron who does not comply with these rules may be prosecuted, refused entry or directed to leave the Camp Ground and/or Venue.

Patrons must not:

1. Distribute any printed or visual matter or promote any material without consent of the Venue and/or Promoter;
2. Distribute, hawk or sell any goods and services;
3. Misuse, deface, damage, remove from the Circuit or tamper with any building, fence, seat, chair, table, structure, vehicle, object, electrical equipment, plumbing, wiring of the Venue;
4. Litter. Please place all rubbish in bins provided.
5. Cause any nuisance, interfere with any other person's property, behave in any manner that may disrupt or interrupt the Event or cause unreasonable inconvenience to any Patron, official or employee of the Venue and/or Promoter;

The Venue, Promoter or its representatives, may with reasonable cause, refuse entry to or direct any Patron to leave the Camp Ground.

## CHILDREN

Patrons who bring children to the Camp Ground are responsible for the care, conduct and supervision at all times.

## LOSS OF PROPERTY

Patrons are responsible for their own property. The Venue and/or Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage to any property brought into the Event and Camp Ground.

## CURFEW

Lights and noise must cease at 10pm. If working in Pit Garages lights and power tools must be switched off by 10pm.
